Ex.1 : complète les phrases du discours indirect

- a. « I have a toothache. » \rightarrow He said that he had a toothache.
- b. « I will open the window. » \rightarrow He told me (that) he would open the window.
- c. « We are going to the cinema. » \rightarrow They said (that) they were going to the cinema.
- d. « I don't know. » \rightarrow She said (that) she didn't know.
- e. « Mr.Smith will be here in a second. » → The secretary announced that Mr Smith would be there in a second.
- f. « We don't want to go ! » \rightarrow The children said (that) hey didn't want to go.
- g. « I am leaving town tomorrow » → She announced (that) she was leaving town the next/following day.
